Re: Special notice about WETT Identification Card Expiration Stickers

All WETT certificate holders have been issued ID cards. In addition to listing the level of certification achieved, this card also carries an expiration date sticker. Normally, all WETT members who renew their certification receive a new expiration sticker before the end of the year.

This year the WETT office moves in December. To avoid confusion with renewal notices being sent to the wrong address, WETT has intentionally delayed the renewal process by 2 months.

All members who renew with WETT will received a new expiration sticker before March 31, 2006. Consequently, after that date ID cards with an expiration date of December 31, 2005 will no longer be valid.
